The filthy conditions, the smell of urine in the room.

Being locked in the room, The lack of hygiene, nowhere to wash dishes, the lack of toilet facilities (which is now being corrected) and the fact there was no glass on the girls windows AND it would be cold at night

IS THERE ANYTHING THAT WOULD HAVE MADE YOUR VOLUNTEER EXPERIENCE MORE ENJOYABLE OR REWARDING?

The food at house is mediocre. There is a lot of wasted food and not much imagination in the preparation. Other than that the house was great. The kids are great at clearing up after themselves as best they can.

DO YOU HAVE ANY SUGGESTIONS FOR OTHER VOLUNTEERS?

They love to sing and dance, color, I played games with them I bought oranges and say a word in Spanish and if they could guess the word in English I would throw them an orange. If you can afford it bring BUNS and fruit or eggs. (nutritious food!) VERY emotional - you want to take them all home with you!

OTHER FEEDBACK OR COMMENTS?

They turn off the water heaters at night and in the morning we have cold showers, but more importantly I think it is more expensive to heat up cold water than keep it hot.

The kids need to get out! It is not healthy for them to be inside all day with no fresh air or exercise.

There needs to be better hygiene. Some of the children reek of urine and have not bathed or had clean clothes for weeks or months. More water, more food. Bedding should be washed once in a while
