About Nepal

Phase I: Language and Cultural Immersion Program (2 weeks) (optional)

Global Crossroad's Nepal volunteer experience starts with two weeks of language and cultural program in the vibrant city of Kathmandu. You may choose to take the Language and Cultural Immersion Program or go directly into a volunteer project. In the program, you will taste ethnic Nepali life, allowing you to adapt to the culture in a informed and relaxed way. Activities feature language and culture classes, informative lectures, inspiring visits to cultural and religious sites in Kathmandu, and exhilarating village hiking. The second week takes volunteers to a rural village for an authentic home stay experience - not found in the usual tourist guides. Finally, volunteers travel to Royal Chitwan National Park to take part in a memorable jungle safari, learn traditional dances, and further explore the mystery of Nepal—all at a remarkably low price.

Phase II: Teaching English to Buddhist (1-12 weeks)

Nepal is the country where the apostle of peace Lord Buddha was born. Buddha spread the message of Buddhism all across the world. Tibet is also a Buddhist country and there are more than 130,000 Tibetans who live in exile and out of that over 20% of them are living in Nepal. Despite of all difficulties, these exiled Buddhists are practicing their religion and rebuilding their cultural heritage in their own little ways. In this mission of the Tibetans in Nepal, education of the children is the top most priority and command of English is very important.

Role of the Volunteer

Volunteers will primarily work as English instructors either the schools of Tibetan Children's Village. Depending upon the need, volunteers may be asked to assist in other school extra curricular activities like sports. As a unique facet of this placement, the volunteer will have a rare and unique opportunity to witness and participate in traditional Buddhist rituals.
