Phase I: Language and Cultural Immersion Program (1 week - Optional)

This week-long language and cultural immersion program features an informative and fascinating package which helps our volunteers to prepare for a successful, enriching volunteer experience. Participating volunteers learn basic Sinhalese phrases and verbs which help them to feel comfortable as well as to more optimally understand the Sri Lankan way of life. Volunteers also experience a multitude of immersion opportunities while visiting some of Sri Lanka's most spectacular, awe-inspiring sites and memorable, often life-changing attractions. You will join the volunteer service project after the completion of language and cultural program.

Phase II: Teaching English (1-12 weeks)

The importance of English, much like the rest of the world, is very significant in Sri Lanka. People are striving towards prosperous lives through the knowledge of English which helps secure high-paying jobs. The young students of Sri Lanka are in search of greater English foundations, as well as the teachers who are working towards the development of the future generation.

Our volunteers work with our local partners who have established English schools in Galle and rural areas of Sri Lanka helping provide basic English education to the children between the ages 6-16. Depending on the interest of volunteers, other subjects like math, science and physical education can also be taught to the enthusiastic students.

Role of a Volunteer

Depending on the interest of the volunteers, they can teach English, Math, Science, or Physical education as well as the following daily activities:

- Teach conversational English, Math, or Science to students between the ages of 6 -16 in different standards
- Use gestures, flash cards, artwork, music and songs to motivate the children in their learning
- Interact with the students in English
- Help the school administration (depending on need)

The Sri Lanka Volunteer Program starts on the first and third Monday of each month.
