In Thailand, we offer comprehensive volunteer programs which are comprised of three phases:

Phase I Language and Cultural Immersion Program (One week - Optional)

Phase II Volunteer Project (3-12 weeks)

Phase III Optional Travel packages

Phase I: Language and Cultural Immersion Program (1 week - Optional)

The Language and Cultural Immersion Program is a one week adventure in cross-cultural learning, language study, and travel. Your program is an orientation that will acclimate you to Thai culture, religions, politics, climates, and other issues related to volunteering in Thailand. The first 3 days of language class focus on learning basics of the Thai language, and the second phase will provide the opportunity to practice Thai by living with a host family. The second part of the program also includes orientation to Thai culture and traditions, with sight-seeing in the nearby areas. In summary, this one week program offers you intriguing glimpses of Thailand and an in-depth understanding of the country and people – allowing you to make the most of volunteer experience.

Phase II: Volunteer in a Child Development Center (3-12 weeks)

There are many Child Development Centers for disadvantaged children in cities and factory areas in Thailand. These centers are close to schools are being run by various groups, ranging from the local government, communities, to temples or foundations. They attempt to provide services to poor families who have low-paying jobs (mostly the factory workers) and can't afford child care services for their children. The parents drop the children off before they go to work and pick them up afterwards, much like a day-care center. Volunteers are desperately needed, as many of these child care centers have very few resources and are extremely understaffed.

Role of the Volunteer

The volunteers teach English in child development centers and nurseries. Volunteers will teach practical conversational English by telling stories, playing games, and performing plays. Volunteers will also teach specific vocabulary, grammar, and pronunciation.

Volunteers can get involved in any of following activities:

- Teach Conversational English
- You can do extra curricular activities like games, drawing, music, etc
- Assist the teachers practice English
- Teach specific vocabulary, grammar, and pronunciation
